Highlights from our events

Overdose Awareness Day and Memorial Walk

April 29: Eddystone Lighthouse Hall, Eddystone. This community event was to remember those lost to the disease of addiction, and to support those actively fighting the disease. Magellan had a table at the event with over 6,000 people in attendance. Many people talked with Julie Brown of Magellan about how appreciative they are for their services as they shared their personal stories of recovery.

#Hold on You Matter – Suicide Prevention Walk

April 30: Bucks County Technical High School, Fairless Hills. This event was organized by the Bucks County Suicide Prevention Task Force. The goals of the event and the Task Force are to reduce stigma, increase the number of individuals seeking help, support individuals who have lost a loved one to suicide and to reduce the number suicides in Bucks County. Eve Hauser and Emily Ferris attended this event for Magellan that had over 400 people in attendance and spoke to members and other stakeholders about their availability to be helpful community resources.
