Transitional Housing Program Proposals

Behavioral Health of Cambria County (BHoCC) seeks to implement a Transitional Housing Program with one provider in late summer 2021. Proposals are requested for a Transitional Housing service. The Transitional Housing Program in Cambria County will be a County-wide, voluntary, mobile service carried out by trained Housing Coordinators. Transitional Housing is meant to address the immediate housing needs of individuals awaiting long-term, safe, affordable permanent housing. The program will be funded through county reinvestment dollars initially, to be sustained by contributions by Cambria County grant makers.
